INTRODUCTION

Joanne called the meeting to order at 9:05 AM. The outstanding minutes from July through Sept. were approved. New EGT appointee Evan Crumiller introduced himself and was welcomed to the group.

DISCUSSION

Sustainable Jersey recently announced a new round of grant opportunities. Jo and Lee Farnham, Chairman of the Ewing Environmental Commission, are working together with Township Administration to apply for one in the amount of \$20,000. One of the conclusions of our community visioning effort focused on the beauty of trees, and the need to preserve them. This grant's objective is to deliver on that vision. Our already very low tree canopy of 27% vs. the statewide average of 40%, and the emerging emerald ash borer problem in Mercer County also necessitate developing an action plan aimed at improving our tree canopy. They have met with Bill Brash, the NJ certified forester who has worked with the township previously. The deadline for application is Feb 7.

A bike rack has been ordered for the Ewing Senior and Community Center [ESCC] with the remainder of the money from the previous grant. This purchase completes the spending for that grant. Once the invoice is received, the final grant report will be submitted to Sustainable Jersey so that we can apply for the tree funds.

SUSTAINABLE JERSEY RECERTIFICATION

The purpose of this January retreat was to launch the Sustainable Jersey recertification effort for 2016. Sustainable Jersey timelines, award levels (bronze and silver), and priority actions were given an overview. Michael went over the Sustainable Jersey website in detail so that all members would know where to find

CERTIFICATION LEVELS




Bronze certification requires:

- Establishment of **mandatory** green team
- Implement 2 of 12 priority actions
- Complete actions in 6 of 19 categories
- Total of at least 150 points

Silver certification requires:

- Establishment of **mandatory** green team
- Implement 3 of 12 priority actions
- Complete actions in 8 of 19 categories
- Total of at least 350 points

SUMMARY – IMPORTANT DEADLINES

- **June 5** – Deadline for Application, some items can be incomplete as long as they are completed by the revised application deadline.
- **Sept 11** – Revised Application
- **Nov 20** – Final Application for 2016
