The group will operate independently of our appointed boards and will meet to explore local and regional trails, enjoy nature, get a little exercise and just have some fun while walking/hiking/biking. It is open to everyone. They will ride or walk trails in Mercer County area. The first expedition is scheduled for Saturday, July 9, 7:00 a.m. starting at the [Bearley House](#), a historic Georgian brick house built in 1761 in Lawrenceville.

Beautification Campaign – Garden Tour

Jo reported that at least 45 people attended the Garden Tour that we co-hosted along with the West Trenton Garden Club and Girl Scout Troop 70138. The event earned \$450 which was split equally between the three organizers. Our share, \$150, will be put toward prizes for the Scarecrow Contest in October. The partnership worked extremely well and the Ewing Township Historical Preservation Society provided excellent support. Our hope is for an even bigger and better event next year. We might try to run some kind of contest for the neighborhoods with the best looking gardens? ... That would tie in with Caroline's neighborhood work. Sustainable Jersey Recertification Submission

On June 5th Michael and Joanne finished the uploads for our Sustainable Jersey recertification. Our actions were worth a total of 480 points. This would qualify us for Silver certification if all actions were accepted. We should begin to hear from Sustainable Jersey in about 4 -6 weeks with specific feedback for our submissions. We will have an opportunity to correct/complete any actions requiring additional work. The second submission deadline is Sunday, Sept 11th.




FIGURE 3 - HIDDEN TREASURE - THE ANTHEIL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL COURTYARD GARDEN
