- Trees - CFMP report (COMMUNITY FORESTRY MANAGEMENT PLAN). The plan is to hire a certified forester to complete the plan and Inventory, which is required. We will apply for a grant: \$15k for inventory, \$5k for plan. DEP grant, Division of Forestry
- Native Plant Initiative – Dan / Ryan / Devin...no update.
- Bike ride – George Steward. Scope=permit approved in September. Start/stop at Campus Town. Coordinating with Ewing PD to support throughout the Township @ intersections. Ride scheduled for 10/18.
- Resolution in support of New Jersey passing a Climate Superfund Act. (Lexy and Dave) report. Ewing passed this resolution, 49th municipality to do so.
- Clean Communities - Karen NO REPORT
  - Delaware River Cleanup? Was anyone able to attend? Twenty bags of trash from half a dozen volunteers.
  - Fall Cleanup – partnerships to get better turn out?
- SJ – Joanne. Sustainable Jersey certified bronze -- 9/24/25 :) award is in November at League of Municipalities luncheon in Atlantic City. Need new badge for letterhead/website.

## New Business Possibilities

- Karen - speaker from Rutgers Cooperative Extension - Mercer County. Justine Gray is interested in speaking at our next meeting; discussing natives and tree planting procedures?
- Ongoing update needed - ERI /NRI (Environmental Resource Inventory / Natural Resource Inventory). Last done in 2016, needs update in 2026 - also the update to the Master Plan is being worked on.
- More continuing ed...
  - A lot of us have minimal actual environmental training and we need to do what we can to up our game. More speakers... more webinars, CEUs. Perhaps someone can volunteer to stay on top of continuing ed opportunities and share them with the group...? We need CEUs for urban and community forestry division accreditation. Consider setting CEU goals for EGT members?
